Direttore generale del Dipartimento delle Antichità della Palestina (Gaza), dal 1991 è docente di archeologia e di storia dell'architettura presso le Università di Gaza.

Dal 2003 è "Research Associate" presso l'"Oriental Institute" dell'Università di Chicago.

Dirige il "Trustees Council of Gaza Community College for Tourism Studies", la "Palestinian Fulbright Alumni Association (PFAA)" ed il "Philistia Center for Studies and Cultural Development". Dal 2004 è componente del Comitato scientifico della Seda palestinese dell'Osservatorio per la Protezione dei Beni Culturali in Area di Crisi dell'I.S.Fo.R.M.

È stato, anche, docente presso l'University of Chicago (2002/2003) e presso la Montclair State University (2006).

Ha diretto molteplici scavi archeologici e progetti connessi alla valorizzazione del patrimonio culturale di Gaza.

Ha pubblicato oltre 30 lavori scientifici su riviste internazionali .

Prof. Sadeq is Director General of the Palestinian Dept. of Antiquities (Gaza) and, since 1991 he is professor of archaeology and history of architecture at Gaza Universities. Since 2003 he is Research Associate, the Oriental Institute, the University of Chicago. He chairs the "Trustees Council of Gaza Community College for Tourism Studies" and the "Palestinian Fulbright Alumni Association (PFAA)". Since 2004 he is a member of the Observatory for the protection of Cultural heritage in Areas of Crisis (I.S.Fo.R.M.). Prof. Sadeq has directed a large number of archaeological excavations with local and international colleagues and institutions in the Gaza Strip, as well as performed environmental impact assessment studies focusing on the historical heritage, and conducted research in archaeology and related fields (environment, tourism, eco-tourism). Outside the Middle East he taught at the University of Chicago (2002/2003) and Montclair State University, New Jersey (2006). Prof. Sadeq has published more than 30 scientific papers in international journals, and more than 20 scripts for cultural documentary films related to Palestinian culture, tourism, and eco-tourism. Among his contributions in the field of cultural tourism he moderated a TV program and contributed to tourist guides, the most recent one titled "This is Palestine" (2005). He published the following books: "Die Mamlukische Architektur Der Stadt Gaza" (1991), Islamic Archaeology of Busra (translation into Arabic, 1991); West Bank and Gaza Strip, a historical and archaeological guide (co-author, 1999).
